Family Representatives Role

- 1. Meet the Childrens Disability Network Manager and discuss issues, ideas for resolution raised at the Family Forum
- 2. Represent Balbriggan Family Forum (one year term) at the Family Representative Group with the other eleven areas (4 meetings per year). Discuss issues and ideas for improvements based on general themes from the Family Forum
- 3. Attend all Family Forums (around 3-4 meetings per year)
- 4. Ensure there is feedback to the Balbriggan Forum about items raised, suggestions and resulting actions



Family Representatives Group - summary

- 1. Attend with Reps from 11 other Networks
- 2. Representatives from this group will attend Operational Management Group and Governance Group
- 3. To raise issues for discussion and resolution at appropriate levels of the governance structure
- 4. Feedback to the Family Forums.
