This is an exciting opportunity to lead a dedicated team of Physiotherapists to provide a high standard of clinical care in line with the CRC strategic plan across CRC schools and specialist services while also managing a clinical caseload. The post holder will lead the department in a National context of change in disability services, including Progressing Children's Disability Services for Children and Young People.

This post is based in CRC Clontarf. CRC has locations in Clondalkin, Waterford and Limerick. The post holder will travel to other sites and outreach clinics as required for service delivery.

The Physiotherapy Manager will have overall responsibility for the management, delivery and development of the Physiotherapy service in CRC Specialist Services.

Reporting to the Head of Specialist Service in CRC Clontarf, the successful candidate will have the following **essential** requirements:

- Possess a recognized degree or equivalent that is approved by CORU and be registered with CORU.
- Have at least five years postgraduate experience with at least two of these at a senior level in the area of physical disability.
- Excellent communication, initiative, time management and teamwork skills.
- Experience in management, supervision, and leadership in the areas of operational and strategic planning.
- Working knowledge of HSE Progressing Disability Services for Children and Young People and New Directions policy.
- Experience of working with children and families in the area of disability.
- Evidence of participation in relevant CPD
